All climbing in Skypark is at your own risk.

In the park you are responsible for your own safety by following Skypark rules:

- You must take part in the safety instructions and follow all the instructions provided by Skypark staff.
- Loose items must be stored in a locked pocket during climbing (e.g. keys, wallet, etc.).
- Long hair must be tied up. Avoid wearing rings, necklaces etc. when climbing.
- Maximum weight is 120 kg.
- You may not be affected by drugs or alcohol.
- You are not allowed to smoke in the park area. Neither while wearing the equipment or within 3 meters of a harness.
- If you are pregnant, have epilepsy and have neck- or back problems you must let the staff know when you check in. And you must determine your self if you can climb.
- If you have a health problem that may affect your climbing, please make sure to inform the staff at check-in.
- If you are careless or if you lose or deliberately destroy the equipment, you will be liable for damages. The charge will be 4500 kr per harness and 450 kr per helmet.
- For participants under the age of 18, a signature by the legal guardian is required for climbing.
- You accept to receive information and news from Skypark via email.

IMPORTANT:

For participants under the age of 10, you (legal guardian) also accept the following terms:

- As an accompanying adult/guardian, you are responsible for the safety of children and to ensure that they comply with Skypark rules.
- Children under the age of 11 must always bring an accompanying climbing adult (minimum age 18) with them in the courses while climbing.

The accompanying adult may be responsible for maximum 3 children.
